*Warsaw – Kazimierz Dolny – Lublin – Kozlowka – Zamosc – Lwow –
Lancut – Lezajsk – Rzeszow – Sanok – Zakopane -Krakow*

JUL 17 – 28, 2010

- Sat, July 17- WARSAW (dinner)
Arrive Warsaw and transfer to hotel .
6.00pm meet in lobby for dinner .
- Sun, July 18- WARSAW (breakfast , lunch)
After breakfast sightseeing of Warsaw including the Old Market Square , Barbican ,
drive along the Royal Route from the Castle to Lazienki Park .
- Mon, July 19-WARSAW-KAZIMIERZ DOLNY –LUBLIN (breakfast , lunch)
After breakfast departure from Warsaw to Kazimierz Dolny, an ancient and picturesque Renaissance town on the Vistula river with a thriving artistic community .
Here we will spend some time seeing the sights and then after lunch enjoy some free time to visit the quaint shops looking for one of a kind treasures or to further explore the Old Town.
Late afternoon we continue to Lublin for overnight .
- Tue, July 20- LUBLIN – KOZLOWKA-LUBLIN (breakfast , dinner)
Morning sightseeing of Lublin including the Old Town with its Royal Castle and Holy Trinity Chapel (14thc)
Free time for lunch and then we drive to Kozlowka to visit the baroque Palace of the Zamoyski family .
This well-preserved residence features art exhibits and beautiful geometric gardens.
Return to Lublin for dinner and overnight.
- Wed, July 21- LUBLIN – ZAMOSC – LWOW (breakfast, dinner)
After breakfast we depart for Lwow . Enroute we stop in Zamosc to visit the Old Town complex which is a UNESCO heritage site. After short sightseeing we continue east towards the border and our destination today – Lwow . Arrival in Lwow late afternoon . Dinner at local restaurant .
- Thu, July 22- LWOW (breakfast , dinner)
Full day of exploring this amazing city . Sights will include : Market Square , City Hall, Cathedrals, Prospekt Svobody, Armenian Street , Lychakiv Cemetery , Open-Air Museum Shevchenkiv Gai ++
Dinner and overnight in Lwow.
- Fri, July 23- LWOW – LAN CUT –LEZAJSK-RZESZOW (breakfast, dinner)
We leave Lwow and cross the border back into Poland towards Rzeszow . Enroute we will visit Lancut Palace with its famous Coach Museum. Continue to Lezajsk for an Organ Concert performed at the Basilica . Arrival in Rzeszow for dinner and overnight.
- Sat, July 24- RZESZOW - SANOK - ZAKOPANE (breakfast, dinner)
After breakfast we head south to Sanok where we will visit Poland's largest open air Museum. There are about 100 traditional buildings here providing insight into the cultural heritage and mix of the ethnic groups which inhabited this Polish-Ukrainian borderland. Continue to Zakopane for dinner and overnight.

Sun, July 25-ZAKOPANE (breakfast, lunch)

Morning sightseeing of this lively resort town including cable-car ride to top of Gubalowka Mountain for a panoramic view of the surrounding area . After lunch you have free time to enjoy the highlander hospitality and to wander the market place where you can find local specialties such as artistic leather works , wood carvings , and local cheeses .

Mon, July 26- ZAKOPANE – DUNAJEC RIVER RAFTING- WIELICZKA SALT MINE – KRAKOW (breakfast,dinner)

After breakfast we leave Zakopane . Our first adventure this morning is a leisurely rafting ride on the Dunajec River through the Pieniny mountain range . Our next stop will be the Wieliczka Salt Mine, a UNESCO World Heritage site . It is one of the world’s oldest mining sites that has been operating since the 13th century Our underground tour will lead through galleries and caverns with unique sculptures all carved from rock salt. After our tour we will enjoy dinner at a local restaurant in Wieliczka and then a short drive will take us to our hotel in Krakow for overnight.

Tue, July 27- KRAKOW (OPTIONAL TRIP TO AUSCHWITZ - approx 60 Cad \$) (breakfast, dinner)

Morning sightseeing of Krakow including Old Market Square with its famous Cloth hall, St Mary’s Church, Wawel Hill with Royal Castle and Cathedral , afternoon free time for last minute exploring , shopping or Optional trip to Auschwitz.

Farewell dinner at a local restaurant .

Wed, July 28- KRAKOW (breakfast)

After breakfast end of tour . Transfer to airport in Krakow,
