

GET CLOSER TO CHOPIN AND HIS MUSIC

4 days



Route: **Warsaw – Nieborów – Żelazowa Wola – Brochów – Sanniki – Warsaw**



Żelazowa Wola – Chopin's manor house

Day 1. Warsaw

Arrival of the group in Warsaw. Meeting with your guide at the airport and transfer to your hotel. Check-in and time to relax after your flight. Welcome dinner at a local restaurant. A Chopin concert presenting world-famous mazurkas and polonaises, played by top pianists. A glass of wine will be served during the interval.

Day 2. Warsaw

A tour following in the footsteps of Frédéric Chopin. A half-day tour of Warsaw starting with a stop by the Holy Cross Church where the heart of Chopin, brought from Paris, rests. A visit to the Chopin Drawing Room where Chopin performed his études, some polonaises, and mazurkas for the first time. The building bears a commemorative plaque to Chopin. A visit to the Chopin museum located in the Ostrogski Castle – the Frédéric Chopin Society. The museum exhibition is divided into two parts: the display on the ground floor is titled "Chopin in Poland" and shows Chopin's life in Poland till 1830. The room on the first floor holds an exhibition called "Chopin abroad" and presents Chopin's travels to Vienna, Paris and other European cities. A stop by the Protestant Church of the Holy Trinity where Chopin used to sing in a choir. See the Church of the Sisters of the

Visitation, where in October 1825 Chopin was an organist. Continue with a stop at the Royal Łazienki Park to see the famous Chopin Monument and the Belvedere, a Classicist brick palace where Chopin used to give concerts as a young boy, invited by the Grand Duke Konstanty. Stop at the Powązki Cemetery where you will see the grave of Chopin's parents. Continue the tour with the Castle Square where you can see the column of King Sigismund, the Market Square and the Monument of the Warsaw Uprising, and drive to see the Ghetto Memorial. Dinner at a local restaurant and transfer to the National Opera House to attend an evening performance. Afterwards, transfer back to your hotel.

Day 3. Warsaw – Nieborów – Żelazowa Wola – Brochów – Sanniki – Warsaw

A morning departure for a tour of Warsaw vicinities. Drive to Nieborów to visit beautiful interiors of the Radziwiłł family residence with the famous antique sculpture of

Niobe. Afterwards, drive to Żelazowa Wola, the birthplace of Frédéric Chopin. See the former manor house, now a museum devoted to our great composer and his family. The Youth of Chopin – a concert dedicated to Chopin's compositions from the period of his youth. Listen to a Chopin concert presenting the composer's sonatas, waltzes and variations well-known and played in many countries of Europe and other parts of the world. See the Brochów village famous for its Gothic parish church that witnessed many important events from the Chopin family life. Continue to Sanniki where Chopin came in the summer of 1828 to visit a classmate of his. The village hosts the Frédéric Chopin Memorial Centre with an exhibition devoted to Chopin. Drive back to Warsaw.

Day 4. Warsaw

After breakfast: transfer to the airport for your flight back home.
