

Rzucewo – JAN III SOBIESKI Castle

Location: on the beautiful western cliff of Zatoka Pucka (Puck Bay). The castle is surrounded by a historical scenic park. Distance from Gdańsk: 30km.

Description: Neo-Gothic palace from mid-19th century, designed by the German architect Friedrich August Stüler in 1846.

Accommodation: lodgings for ca. 50 guests. Comfortable rooms, including 6 single rooms and 15 double rooms with optional extra beds, a room in the tower, 5 suites.

Guests may use: restaurant, café, wine bar, Hunting House, Stained-Glass Hall, Golden Hall, Clock Hall, Seal Hunters Hall – banqueting hall.

Additionally: playroom and playground, sauna, gym, massage, tennis courts, volleyball court, billiards, bikes, horse rides.

Conference facilities: 5 conference rooms for 10–90 guests.



Krag – PODEWILS Castle



Location: in Western Pomerania, halfway from Szczecin to Gdańsk, 30km from the Baltic Sea and ca. 40km from Koszalin and Słupsk.

Description: 15th-century knight's castle, repeatedly rebuilt, surrounded by forests and lakes.

Accommodation: lodgings for 120 guests in double rooms and suites, with satellite TV, radio, minibar, telephone, Internet access, hairdryer.

Guests may use: restaurant with a deck and a great view of the lake, sauna, fitness room, massage, water sports equipment, bikes, horses.

Conference facilities: 5 rooms, max 150 guests

Strzeżęcino – AMBER and WHITE Palaces

Location: in a picturesque area of Central Pomerania, 140km from Gdańsk and 230km from Berlin. The estate is surrounded by a scenic park with parts of an 18th-century French garden. Another asset is the proximity of the lake.

Description: the exclusive hotel complex is made of: the Amber Palace, the Hunter's Residence and the White Palace.

Accommodation: rooms equipped with period furniture. A total of 63 rooms and 4 suites.

Guests may use: restaurant, night club, indoor swimming pool and outdoor swimming pool, Jacuzzi, Finnish sauna, inhalations, Scottish hydromassage, solarium, massage, aromatherapy, cardio-fitness studio with a weight trainer, treadmill, stepper, ergometers, rowing machines, elliptical trainer, bodyformer.

Conference facilities: max 150 guests.



Ryn – RYN Castle



Location: dominates over the town of Ryn, located on an isthmus between Lake Olów and Lake Ryńskie that are part of the Great Masurian Lakes route.

Description: a unique hotel in a 14th-century Teutonic Knights' castle, one of world's largest edifices of the type.

Accommodation: 143 single and double rooms and high-standard suites, with interior design related to the castle's architecture.

Guests may use: Gothic restaurant for 300 guests. It offers specialties of the Old Polish, noble and European cuisines. Castle wine bar – its stylish interior reminds of the times when Ryn had vineyards known in this part of Europe. Knight's Inn – near the castle, makes you familiar with the atmosphere of historical feasts. Recreation Centre is another treasure hidden in the castle's cellars. Its stylish cellars offer a swimming pool with many facilities, hydromassage, three saunas, comfortable beds, massage, beauty parlour and solarium.

Conference facilities: 5 modern and professionally equipped conference rooms, for a total of 700 guests.



Krasiczyn – Castle and Park Complex

Location: in south-eastern Poland, 10km from the historical city of Przemyśl. A great staging area for trips to Bieszczady and Lviv.

Description: a Renaissance 16th-century castle, surrounded by a splendid park with plenty of animal and plant species.

Accommodation: 92 places in single, double and three-person rooms.

Guests may use: restaurant, winter park.

Conference facilities: 10 rooms, max 300 guests.



Baranów Sandomierski – Palace and Park Complex



Location: in south-eastern Poland, in the fork of River Vistula and River Kamienica. Distance from Krakow: 200km, distance from Warsaw: 300km.

Description: the palace is one of the most precious buildings of the Polish Renaissance age, called "the Small Wawel". A special highlight is the 14-hectare park that is perfect for walking.

Accommodation: 12 places in the Castle and 54 places in a modern hotel buildings erected on the foundations of the former servants' house. All the rooms have satellite TV and telephones.

Guests may use: 2 restaurants, historical interiors museum, biological regeneration (sauna, solarium, gym), bike rental service.

Conference facilities: 6 rooms, max 200 guests.



Maciejewo – MACIEJEWO Palace

Location: in Western Pomerania, 50km from Szczecin, 12km from the International Szczecin–Goleniów Airport. The complex is surrounded by a splendid park with impressive tree specimens. Near the palace, there are hunting areas and an 18-hole golf course in Binowo.

Description: the palace was built at the end of the 19th century as a von Fleming family residence.

Accommodation: 48 rooms (single, double and suites) with satellite TV, radio, telephone.

Guests may use: restaurant, café, bar, indoor swimming pool, sauna, solarium, massage, billiards, tennis court, water sports equipment, bikes, horse rides.

Conference facilities: 2 rooms, max 300 guests..



Wiejce – WIEJCE Palace



Location: in a picturesque scenery, among lakes of Western Poland. The palace is surrounded by a park with some old-growth forest. Distance from Poznań: 80km, from the Polish–German border: 90km.

Description: the palace and park complex was built in mid-19th century. It is composed of the palace and 3 buildings: Rządówka (Bailiff's House), Folwark (Grange) and Domek Ogrodnika (Gardener's House).

Accommodation: stylish rooms in the palace and rustic-style rooms in three other buildings. Palace: 30 single and double rooms; 2 suites; Rządówka: 8 single and double rooms, 2 suites; Folwark: 19 double rooms; Domek Ogrodnika: 4 double rooms.

Guests may use: restaurant, grill bower, biological regeneration, Finnish sauna, steam sauna, Jacuzzi, billiards, bowling alley, mini golf, horses, angling, bikes.

Conference facilities: 6 rooms, max 350 guests.

Rydzyzna – RYDZYNA Castle

Location: at the main Poznań–Wrocław road, 90km from both these cities. The residence is surrounded by a 12-hectare park.

Description: built at the end of the 17th century as a residence of King Stanisław Leszczyński. After many ups and downs, the castle finally regained its glory. The stylish interiors are furnished with period furniture and historical prints. The castle's attraction are biological collections (including tropical butterflies).

Accommodation: 46 single and double rooms.

Guests may use: restaurant, grill garden, mini-gym, billiards.

Conference facilities: 6 rooms, max 370 guests.



Jelenia Góra – PAULINUM Palace



Location: in south-western Poland, on the outskirts of Jelenia Góra.

Description: after painstaking renovation works, the 19th-century residence hidden in a park has become a stylish hotel and a professional conference and leisure facility. The natural and varied relief of the park area provides plenty of recreation opportunities.

Accommodation: single and double rooms, all with period furniture, satellite TV, telephone (Internet access possible). The palace offers a total of 65 places.

Guests may use: restaurant, bar, recreation: dry sauna, steam sauna, Jacuzzi, salt chamber, workout equipment, mountain bikes.

Conference facilities: 1 room, max 110 guests and several small rooms.



Wojanów – WOJANÓW Palace

Location: in south-western Poland in Rudawy Janowickie, within Rudawski Scenic Park, ca. 6km from Jelenia Góra, 20km from Karpacz.

Description: a thoroughly renovated palace and park complex that includes the palace, annexes, stables, granary, coach house, barn.

Accommodation: single, double, 3-person and 4-person rooms with satellite TV, Internet access and telephone. The palace offers a total of 200 places at different standards. The palace's stylish interiors highlight its historical character.

Guests may use: two restaurants, café, wine bar, garden bar, two restaurant gardens, tea house, tennis courts, volleyball and basketball courts, swimming pool, Jacuzzi, sauna, fitness facilities, biological regeneration, workout rooms, attended car park.

Conference facilities: 2 rooms, max 250 guests.



Leśna – CZOCHA Castle



Location: in Śląskie voivodeship, ca. 150km from Wrocław, Dresden and Prague. The castle is located halfway from Jelenia Góra and Zgorzelec, near the town of Leśna.

Description: built in mid-13th century from the Czech King Vaclav II, rebuilt over ages, it has become one of the most beautiful historical highlights of Lower Silesia. The building is of a museum character but at the same time freely accessible. Picturesquely located on a high granite spit, surrounded by Lake Leśniańskie, forests and meadows, it is perfect for people who want to relax and forget about the hustle and bustle of the big city, and want to try non-standard forms of recreation and attractions.

Accommodation: 90 places in single, double, 3-person and 4-person rooms at varied standards, located in the Castle and the Castellany.

The Castle offers high-standard Theme Rooms with period-like furniture and Family Rooms in a modern style. The Castellany offers cosy Family Rooms.

Guests may use: restaurant, café, bar, sauna, gym, car park within the defensive walls and a gate, in the summer – cruises on small ships moored to the levee near the castle, guided tour of the castle.
