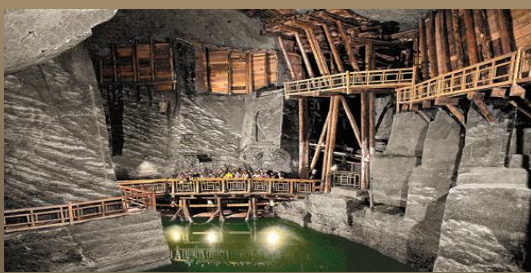

Day 1. Warszawa [D]

Arrival, at 6.00 pm meeting with the Orbis guide at the hotel lobby. Dinner at the hotel.

Day 2. Warszawa [B, D]

After breakfast: sightseeing of **Warszawa**. Before the Second World War Warsaw was called the Paris of the North. Warsaw's **Old City** was destroyed in 90% during the WW II. The brightly painted town houses, churches and the Royal Castle (outside) are all a result of post-war reconstruction. In 1980 the Old City was listed by UNESCO as an example of perfect reconstruction work making use of what had survived from the original buildings. Time for lunch on own and leisure. **Dinner at local restaurant with folklore show.**

Day 3. Warszawa-Częstochowa-Zakopane [B, L]

After breakfast: drive to **Zakopane**, en-route visit to **Częstochowa Jasna Góra Monastery**, with the country's national shrine and the holy picture of the Black Madonna. Lunch. Afternoon: continuing to Zakopane

Day 4. Zakopane [B, D]

After breakfast: sightseeing a lively resort and the best-known mountainous town of **Zakopane**, occupying a small valley between the impressive Poland's highest mountains, Tatra Mountains and the tiny hillside village of Gubałówka, Poland's so-called winter capital some 100km south of Kraków, Zakopane has been attracting the cream of Poland's artistic community. Including excursion by funicular to **Gubałówka Mt.** Afternoon free time. **Dinner with highlanders style folklore show**

Day 5. Zakopane-Kraków [B, L]

After breakfast a unique experience in Europe - a sailing trip down a racing mountain river on the wooden boat, through the breathtaking **Dunajec River Gorge** in the Pieniny Mountains. Lunch. Afternoon: continuing to Krakow

Day 6. Kraków – Wieliczka – Kraków [B, D]

After breakfast: sightseeing of **Kraków**, Poland's cultural capital, with about a quarter of all the country's museum holdings, and European City of Culture for the year 2000. Afternoon visit to stunning **Wieliczka Salt Mine** with beautifully carved chambers, chapels, an underground lake. All made in salt. The mine is frequently referred to as The Underground Salt Cathedral of Poland. Dinner.

Day 7. Krakow – Oświęcim – Wadowice - Kraków [B, D]

After breakfast drive to the mediaeval town of **Oswiecim**, where during the Second World War the Nazis built a death camp in the neighbourhood and called it **Auschwitz**. The site and the memorial museum set up there after the War are now the grim destination for thousands paying homage to those who died there. Return to Krakow via **Wadowice** that has got international recognition as the birthplace of **Pope John Paul II**. Dinner

Day 8. Krakow-Warszawa [B, D]

After breakfast: drive to Warszawa. **Farewell dinner.**

Day 9. Warszawa [B]

After breakfast the end of Orbis services.
