

Day 1. Warszawa [D]

Arrival, meeting with the Orbis guide at the hotel lobby. **Dinner with folklore**.

Day 2. Warszawa [B, L]

After breakfast: sightseeing of **Warszawa**, an extraordinary city in which influences of Western and Eastern Europe culture cross. Here historic buildings, palaces, churches and architectural complexes, destroyed during the War, have been reconstructed with great care. UNESCO appreciated Warsaw Monuments and its relics, and honoured the City by putting the Historic Centre of Warsaw on the World Heritage List. Lunch.

Day 3.Warszawa - Częstochowa - Oświęcim - Zakopane [B, L]

After breakfast: drive to Zakopane, en-route visit to **Częstochowa Jasna Góra Monastery** with the country's national shrine and the holy picture of the Black Madonna. Lunch. Afternoon drive to Oświęcim, visit to **Auschwitz** - former Nazi concentration camp, the memorial museum set up there after the War. It si now the grim destination for thousands paying homage to those who died there. Afternoon continuing to Zakopane.

Day 4. Zakopane-Kraków [B, D]

After breakfast: sightseeing a lively resort and the best-known mountainous town of **Zakopane**, occupying a small valley between the impressive Poland's highest mountains, Tatra Mountains and the tiny hillside village of Gubałówka, Poland's so-called winter capital some 100 km south of Kraków. Zakopane has been attracting the cream of Poland's artistic community. Excursion by funicular car to **Gubałówka Mt.** Afternoon a unique experience in Europe - a raft trip down a racing mountain river on the wooden boat, through the breathtaking **Dunajec River Gorge** in the Pieniny Mountains. Dinner at the restaurant.

Day 5. Kraków- Wieliczka-Krakow [B, D]

After breakfast: sightseeing of **Kraków**, Poland's cultural capital, with about a quarter of all the country's museum holdings, and European City of Culture for the year 2000. Afternoon visit to stunning **Wieliczka Salt Mine** with beautifully carved chambers, chapels, an underground lake. All made in salt. The mine is frequently referred to as The Underground Salt Cathedral of Poland. **Dinner with folklore show at local restaurant.**

Day 6. Kraków-Warszawa [B, L]

After breakfast: drive to Warszawa. Lunch. Afternoon free time.

Day 7. Warszawa [B]

After breakfast the end of Orbis services.
