Route: Warsaw – Żelazowa Wola – Warsaw – Częstochowa – Krakow – Zakopane – Oświęcim – Warsaw

Day 1. Warsaw

Transfer airport–hotel. Sightseeing of Warsaw. Dinner and overnight.

Day 2. Warsaw – Żelazowa Wola – Warsaw

Breakfast at the hotel. Visit to Łazienki, one of the most beautiful park and palace complexes in Europe. Visit to the manor house in Żelazowa Wola, the birthplace of Frédéric Chopin. Dinner at a restaurant. Overnight.

Day 3. Warsaw – Częstochowa – Krakow

Breakfast. Departure to Krakow. En-route visit to Jasna Góra Monastery in Częstochowa, the most important pilgrimage destination in Poland. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Krakow.

Day 4. Krakow

Breakfast at the hotel. Sightseeing of Krakow, Poland's cultural capital, with about a quarter of all the country's museum holdings, and the European City of Culture for the year 2000. In the afternoon, free time. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 5. Krakow – Zakopane

Breakfast. Departure to Zakopane. A trip down a racing mountain river on a wooden boat through the breathtaking Dunajec River Gorge in the Pieniny Mountains. Sightseeing of Zakopane. In the afternoon free time. Dinner at a regional-style restaurant. Overnight.

Day 6. Zakopane – Oświęcim – Warsaw

Breakfast. Departure to Warsaw. En-route visit to the former Nazi concentration camp, Auschwitz-Birkenau. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Warsaw.

Day 7. Warsaw

Breakfast. Transfer to the airport.
